# **ARCHITECTURAL APPLICATION CHECK-LIST**

## No Application Required.

No Architectural Application is required for minor repairs that are (a) made by an Owner *or* do not require more than 8 man-hours of labor, (b) do not require a building permit, (c) do not involve structural modification, (d) do not involve the delivery of bulk construction materials, *and* do not add to or alter any part of a property which is visible from a neighboring property, the street or the Lake – but if all these conditions are not met, an Application is required.

### For All Repairs and Minor Remodels:

- Unless you meet an exception to the rule as provided in the first paragraph of this checklist, you must complete and submit an Architectural Application (3 copies).
- Any fee and security deposit must be paid.
- You must specify the estimated completion date in the Application.

## **For Major Remodels and New Builds:**

All requirements for Architectural Applications specified above must be met, and:

- For longer or multi-stage projects you must attach to your Application a time schedule for the work.
- You may submit either Preliminary Drawings or Final Working Drawings for review; the plans you submit must comply with Architectural Rule 2.10.
- A Construction/Remodeling Agreement must be executed [Architectural Rule 3.3].

## **For Landscaping:**

No Architectural Application is required to replace dying or dead plants or grass with the same or *similar* plants if (a) no Artificial Turf is to be installed *and* (b) the planted area and the footprint remain the same (but Rule 5.14 regarding plants and landscape remains applicable).

If you do not meet (a) *and* (b) above, all requirements for Architectural Applications specified above must be met, and:

- Your Application must include ¼"=1' scale drawings, including plant names, placement, whether existing or new, and plant sizes {see Architectural Rule 2.11].
- See Architectural Rules 5.9.1 (hedges) and 5.14 (Landscaping).

## <u>Additional Requirement for Landscaping with Artificial Turf:</u>

All requirements for Landscape Architectural Applications specified above, and:

- See Rules 5.14.2 (artificial turf). 5.14.1 (rear yard) & 5.14.4 (front yard).
- Submit a brochure and sample of the proposed turf from your supplier (different suppliers have produced different samples of the same brand and model turf....).
- Submit photos of the area to be covered in Artificial Turf.
- Provide square footage calculations for the plantable area and Artificial Turf area (please use the Association's Artificial Turf Calculation Sheet to ensure that all required information is provided, or include that information on your scale drawing).

**Note:** The single biggest reason Architectural Applications are delayed or rejected is that the application doesn't include the items specified in this checklist.
